***Minutes – August 4, 2008 meeting – Parlor Room***

Jane Rupert, chair called the meeting to order and Jim Hall opened with prayer at 6:00 p.m. Minutes were read and approved.

<b>Health Kits</b>	<b><i>Old Business</i></b> Central reached its goal of 100 personal hygiene health kits. Thirty were shipped to Church World Service, seventy given to the Salvation Army of Quincy for flood relief.
<b>American Baptist Men Work Groups</b>	Central housed and fed eleven volunteers from the American Baptist Men of our region on a work tour for flood relief. A big thank you to Franc Langenburg and his cohorts for cooking breakfast and supper for the workers. The men slept on cots in the Scout room.
<b>Hurricane Dolly</b>	Jim shared that Hurricane Dolly damaged the warehouse which stored supplies for the Mexican Mission in Texas. Damages are still being accessed.
<b>School Supplies</b>	<b><i>New Business</i></b> Central has received backpacks and school supplies for sixty-five 1 <sup>st</sup> grade students in Quincy. Members of the Board will ask Sunday school classes to purchase remaining backpacks. The thirty backpacks donated by The Crossing will be sorted and filled with needed supplies. Members will deliver school supplies to First Baptist Church on Wednesday, August 13.
<b>2009 Budget Request</b>	The Board discussed and requested the Trustees set aside a 10% Tithes of 2009 offerings for the mission budget. Jim moved, and Sandra seconded, that the Mission Board add Charles and Sarah West to the 2009 Mission Budget as “special interest missionaries,” and fix the numbers respectfully (proposed budget attached). Motion carried unanimous.
