Committee Reports

- Adult Ministry – no report
- AWANAS – Received 11 out of 30 evaluations sent out. Discussed evaluations—ideas to be implemented in the fall. Plans to start a written form for strikes at Awanas. See attached notes.
- Children – Working on summer Sunday School.

Many people in youth group do not attend Central Sunday mornings. Youth are no longer serving coffee on Sunday mornings. A Family Life/Youth canoe trip is on the calendar for the end of July.
