OLD BUSINESS

The Ministry of Mission will order 100 "Go Boxes" plus all promotional materials costing \$36.00. Completed shoe boxes are due on Monday, Oct. 31, 2011. ABW Sarah Circle will inspect shoe boxes. Motion passed unanimously.

Ruth Mooney, Missionary to Costa Rica – Ruth will be our special missionary speaker on Sunday, October 30 during the 8:30 and 11:00 a.m. She will promote the World Mission Offering while updating the congregation on her ministry in Costa Rica. Peggy will contact someone in the congregation to request they house Ruth for one night. More details of her visit will be discuss at the October meeting.

2012 Budget Request – Romana moves, Marilyn seconded, that the Ministry of Mission asks the Trustees to allocate 10% of general giving to Missions in 2012. Motion passed: 5 Yes, 0 No, 2 Abstentions.

World Mission Offering – Russ moved, Ramona seconded, to set the 2011 World Mission Offering goal at \$3,000.00. Motion passed unanimously. International Ministry brochures will be inserted into the worship bulletins each Sunday starting September 18 to promote the World Mission Offering. Videos will be used during worship to promote the World Mission Offering.
